You might want to include some of your own ideas about the consequences of the changes they have made. What will it mean for the business in both the short and the long term?
- Do you have an idea for a business or a passion that you've always wanted to pursue? Your tutors are interested to know what you could do if you were to run your own business. **Write your own 1 A4 page business plan** and see what the tutors think of your ideas! You should include a discussion of:
 - Your product or service (what it is, how it works, how it will be produced, how it is unique)
 - Your target audience (who they are, where they live, how much they make)
 - Your marketing (how it will be marketed, what sort of advertising you will use, when and where)
 - Your operation (where are you located and why, when are you open, who you employ).
- Develop your **digital skills** by working towards the <u>GSuite Certification</u>.
