Topics	Relevant skills to the topic
Juries and Magistrates	- Evaluating whether unqualified people should decide the outcomes of court cases.

Sentencing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learning the different types of sentences available and evaluating whether prison punishes effectively, or is a university of crime.
Criminal law	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learning the differences between assault, battery, ABH and GBH. - Applying the law to problem scenarios.
