- What are some of the topics and skills that you will cover:

Below are some of the topics and skills that we will cover in A level Spanish:

1. **Social issues and trends**

Aspects of Hispanic society:

- Modern and traditional values (Los valores tradicionales y modernos, la familia)
- Cyberspace (El ciberespacio)
- Equal rights (La igualdad de los sexos)

2. **Political and artistic culture**

Artistic culture in the Hispanic world

- Spanish regional identity (La identidad regional en España)
- Cultural heritage (El patrimonio cultural)

3. Works: You will study one **film**

The aim of this is to develop a detailed understanding of a film in Spanish, acquiring an appreciation of sophisticated and creative uses of the language and understanding it within its cultural and social context. **You will be tested about the film in the written exam (essay)**

<p>Task 1.</p> <p>Watch a Spanish TV Series/Film and write a short summary (10 lines) for each episode</p>	<p>General Content/skills</p> <p>This will help you improve your listening and writing skills. We will be developing these skills further in A level</p>
<p>Task 2.</p> <p>Do some research on the different types of families in Spain.</p> <p>Write a paragraph describing your family in your own words</p>	<p>General Content/skills</p> <p>This will help you with your research skills as well as giving you knowledge of one of the topics we will be studying in A level</p>
<p>Task 3.</p> <p>Go over the vocabulary that you studied in GCSE</p>	<p>General Content/skills</p> <p>This will give you a head start on the vocabulary you will be studying at A level</p>
<p>Task 4.</p> <p>Read some of the '20 minutos' news and translate some of it into English</p>	<p>General Content/skills</p> <p>This will help you improve your translation skills, which we will take further in A level</p>
