

“Let’s Design” Challenge



As part of the “Let’s Design” challenge for students entering the Furniture programmes, they will be asked to design an item of furniture for use by children in primary schools, which can be manufactured using sustainable materials and eco-friendly manufacturing techniques. Within the “Let’s Design” Wood programme, students have to research and design a product, identifying the type of raw materials used, considering sustainable design and investigating production processes, as well as showing their understanding of environmental issues in the wood and timber industries.

Designers should think about making their designs colourful, modern and using products that are easily accessible. You could use recycled paper, card or wood to design something that would be both fun and practical for the children.



The competition will be judged by the Head of Construction David Lord, with the winner receiving a £30 gift voucher for Sutcliffe’s Tools of Burnley.
