HOW TO MAKE LUNAR ROCKS

WHAT YOU NEED

100 grams of baking soda
Black food colouring
Silver and Gold glitter
Water

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

Medium size bowl/container
Spoon
Goggles
Disposable gloves (if you want but not really necessary)

METHOD

In the container/bowl measure out the baking soda add a little amount of black food colouring about 1/4 teaspoon (the more you add the darker the lunar rock will be)

Add the glitter again about 1/4 teaspoon of each.

A little at a time add the water and mix, (if you add too much water all at once the mixture will dissolve) add the water until a firm ball starts to form and all the black food colouring is mixed through.

Shape with your hands into the shape you want then leave it overnight to harden.

If you want to see a lunar rock melt, place back in to the container (once dried) then drizzle vinegar on to the rock and watch it fizz and melt.
