- What are some of the topics and skills that you will cover:

Below are some of the topics and skills that we will cover in A level Spanish:

1. Social issues and trends

Aspects of Hispanic society:

- Equal rights (La igualdad de los sexos)

2. Political and artistic culture

Artistic culture in the Hispanic world

3. Works: You will study one film

The aim of this is to develop a detailed understanding of a film in Spanish, acquiring an appreciation of sophisticated and creative uses of the language and understanding it within its cultural and social context. You will be tested about the film in the written exam (essay)

<u>Task</u>	Link to the course/specification
Task 1.	General Content/skills
Watch a Spanish TV Series/Film and write a short summary (10 lines) for each episode	This will help you improve your listening and writing skills. We will be developing these skills further in A level
Task 2.	General Content/skills
Do some research on the different types of families in Spain. Write a paragraph describing your family in your own words	This will help you with your research skills as well as giving you knowledge of one of the topics we will be studying in A level
Task 3.	General Content/skills
Go over the vocabulary that you studied in GCSE	This will give you a head start on the vocabulary you will be studying at A level
Task 4.	General Content/skills
Read some of the '20 minutos' news and translate some of it into English	This will help you improve your translation skills, which we will take further in A level
