Please find below some information which will help you to prepare for the start of your course.

Equipment (for use in college)

- An A2 or A3 folder with the following equipment;
 - An A3 or A4 sketchbook
 - Drawing pencils
 - A fine liner
 - Eraser
 - A ruler

The above pack is a mandatory piece of equipment. Your folder is your responsibility, and you must bring it to college with you each day. Since this is mandatory, the college has an option that you can purchase when you start your course at a reduced price. You can also seek financial support from the college to pay for this.

You may also wish to purchase the following;

- Glue sticks
- Pens (range: i.e. gel / biro / fine liner)
- Paint brushes: Range of sizes
- Water-colour set
- Charcoal
- Coloured Pastels (oil and chalk)
- General Stationery items

Equipment (optional for use in at home)

Please find below some equipment that you might want to purchase for use at home. These pieces of equipment are also available for use when you are in college.

- Glue gun and glue gun sticks
- Cutting mat
- Scalpel / craft knife (for use at home)
- Colour pencil / crayons (good quality)
- Inks: Drawing (colour) / Quink (black)
- Oil Paint
- White spirit (Turpentine substitute) for oil painting (for use at home)
- Water-colour paper

Should you own your own laptop or iPad, you are free to use these as part of your studies both in and out of the classroom. Please note that this does not include your mobile phones. As part of your studies, you will regularly access digital material, and resources will be shared with you through Google Classroom.

Work Related and Enrichment Activity

As part of your programme of study you will be required to take part in both enrichment and work-related activities. We have a range of work & industry opportunities that you will be expected to be involved with. You will need to work a minimum of 30 hrs outside of class time, this might be working with clients directly or as part of our industry week in January where you will be involved in workshops and talks with industry professionals. You must also complete a minimum of 30 hrs of enrichment. Each week there will be an hour of enrichment included as part of your timetable plus the many trips and visits that we run during the year (see below).
