Your Course: Business Studies

We are delighted to welcome you onto the Business studies course, starting this September. This programme is designed to equip you with the essential knowledge, practical experience, and professional behaviours needed for a successful future career in the Business studies sector.

Learning Overview

Your journey in studying Business Studies at Burnley College will be shaped by a structured curriculum designed to help you grow both personally and professionally. The course you are enrolled on will depend on your previous experience and qualifications, and may include:

- **Level 1 – NCFE Level 1 in Occupational studies**
This introductory course offers a practical insight into the business industry. You'll build essential skills in teamwork, communication and customer service while gaining a foundational understanding of the sector. It's a hands-on, engaging course that prepares you for progression to Level 2 or entry-level roles in the industry.
- **Level 2 – Business Studies**
This course introduces you to the key functions of a business and how they work together for success. You'll explore areas around setting up a business such as marketing, finance and the legal aspects through practical assignments and real-life scenarios. You will also develop workplace skills such as problem-solving, communication, and organisational skills. This course prepares you for further study at Level 3 or entry-level employment in the business world.
- **Level 3 – BTEC Extended Diploma in Business Studies**
This advanced, two-year programme is perfect for students aiming to launch a business career or progress to university. You'll study a wide range of topics including business management, finance, marketing, human resources, and business decision making. With a strong emphasis on real-world application,

- teamwork, and strategic thinking, you'll gain the practical skills and knowledge needed to thrive in a dynamic business environment.

Experiential Learning

You'll take part in practical activities, off-site visits and use real-world scenarios to bring your learning to life.

Equipment

To succeed on the course, please bring the following:

- Basic stationery (pens, pencils, ruler, notepad)
- Ideally, a personal laptop – as most assignment work is completed and submitted electronically via Google Classroom however there are facilities available within college for you to use.

Expectations and Requirements

Professional Expectations

As future business professionals, you are expected to demonstrate high standards of behaviour and personal conduct. This includes:

- **Punctuality** – Arrive on time to all sessions and events
- **Attendance** – Maintain a minimum of 95% attendance
- **Appearance** – Always wear your Burnley College lanyard visibly around your neck
- **Mobile Phones** – Keep phones on silent and out of sight unless authorised for use during a session.

Extended Learning

To support your development, you'll be set regular extended learning activities and independent tasks to complete during your study days. These are designed to deepen your understanding and reinforce what you've covered in class. As a general guideline, you should aim to spend an equal amount of time on independent study and extended learning as you do in taught sessions with your tutor.

Assignments and Assessment

Level 1 and 2 courses are **100% assignment-based**, which may include a range of assessment formats such as written reports, presentations, and practical observations.

- All assignments must be submitted by the deadlines set by your tutor.
- High standards of work and time management are essential for successful completion.

Level 3 – you will complete a total of 4 exams over the 2-year period with another 9 units assessed via a range of methods including reports, presentations, practical activities and professional discussions.

Trips, Visits, and Guest Speakers

You'll benefit from a range of enrichment opportunities throughout the year, including:

- Guest talks from serving and former business professionals
- Overseas and UK visits and trips

Some trips may require specialist clothing or equipment, which your tutor will discuss with you in advance.

In addition to this, you will take part in a weekly enrichment activity and will be expected to undertake a work placement week during the year. Full details will be given to you during the induction day.
