What do I need for this course of study?

Stationery / IT Equipment - If possible, please bring with you a laptop or tablet on normal college days (smartphones are not ideal).

You will also need as a minimum, pens, pencils, lined paper/notebook and A4 folder for organising notes. You are expected to bring these to all your lessons

In preparation for starting college please download the Google classroom, Google Chat, Google Classroom, Google drive and Google Sites.



DBS - Disclosure and Barring Service Application

As part of your programme of study you will be completing work placement in a range of health and social care and/ or Early Years settings. This is a **mandatory** requirement of the qualification. To undertake a work placement, you must have a DBS completed. You cannot continue the programme without a DBS certificate.

To apply for your DBS, you need to attend college on either **Wednesday 26 August** or **Thursday 27 August 09.30- 3.30 in the I-Building**.

3 pieces of identification are needed. Some suggestions: *a passport (must be in date), birth certificate, printed and stamped bank statement (from last 3 months) and provisional driving license.*

Other important information

If you are enrolled on a GCSE alongside your main qualification, you must maintain full attendance. This includes continuing to attend scheduled GCSE lessons during placement blocks on Monday and Tuesday
